

# Betadine Spray



<b>Drug Facts</b>	
<b>Active ingredient</b>	<b>Purpose</b>
Povidone-iodine, 5% (0.5% available iodine),.....	Antiseptic
<b>Uses</b>	
<b>Patient pre-operative skin preparation</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ for preparation of the skin prior to surgery</li> <li>■ helps reduce bacteria that potentially can cause skin irritation</li> </ul>	
<b>Warnings</b>	
<b>For external use only</b>	
<b>Do not use</b> ■ in the eyes ■ If you are allergic to povidone-iodine or any other ingredients in this preparation	
<b>When using this product</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ prolonged exposure to wet solution may cause irritation or, rarely, severe skin reactions</li> <li>■ in pre-operative prepping, avoid "pooling" beneath the patient</li> </ul>	
<b>Stop use and ask a doctor if</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ irritation, sensitization, or allergic reaction occurs and lasts for 72 hours. These may be signs of a serious condition.</li> </ul>	
<b>Keep out of reach of children.</b> If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.	
<b>Directions</b> ■ hold container about 4-6 inches from skin	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ spray desired area ■ allow to dry</li> <li>■ may be bandaged ■ replace cap after use</li> </ul>	
<b>Other information</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ store at 25°C (77°F); excursions permitted between 15°–30°C (59°–86°F). Do not freeze.</li> </ul>	
<b>Inactive ingredients</b> citric acid, dibasic sodium phosphate, glycerin, nonoxynol-9, purified water
